Waterless Surgical Hand Scrub and Healthcare Personnel Handwash

Application Instructions

For Surgical Hand Scrub Use:

Surgicept can be used for first scrub and every scrub of the day.

For the first scrub of the day, clean under nails using a nail pick under running water.

Apply to clean, dry hands.



1. Dispense sufficient quantity of Surgicept® antiseptic to cover one hand (approx. 2mL*) into cupped palm. Dip the fingertips of your opposite hand into Surgicept and work under the nails. Spread remainder of Surgicept on hand and lower two-thirds of forearm.

*Dispenser releases 1mL at a time.



2. Repeat step 1 with other hand and forearm.



3. Dispense an additional sufficient quantity (approx. 2mL) of Surgicept antiseptic, and apply to all surfaces of hands up to wrists, paying particular attention to the nails, cuticles and interdigital spaces. Rub hands until dry. Allow to dry before donning gloves. Do not dry with towel.

For Healthcare Personnel Handwash Use: Wet hands thoroughly with Surgicept and allow to dry without wiping.

Do not use if you are allergic or have known or suspected hypersensitivity to any ingredient in this product. **Stop use and ask a doctor if** irritation, redness or allergic reaction occurs.
